CONDITIONS, REQUIREMENTS AND ASSURANCE

1. The primary function of the parade is to prepare for the Memorial Day ceremony held within the Russian River Cemetery following the end of the parade. The parade will terminate at the entrance of the cemetery on Low Gap Road. In view of that purpose and in reflection of the dedicated service of those who have fallen, inappropriate display of our national colors (e.g., upside-down mounting of the flag, political or protest messages written upon the flag) will not be condoned on the part of parade entries or participants.
2. Owner of vehicle in parade is responsible for complying with state laws.
3. I/We acknowledge and agree that the Parade Committee (Committee) shall determine, at its sole discretion, the appropriateness of my/our entry. The Committee may unilaterally refuse this application or require that it be acceptably amended.
4. I/We acknowledge and agree that the sponsoring organizations, parade committee, volunteers, the City of Ukiah, their respective agents, employees, and any sponsoring entity, its employees and agents are hereby, and will be, indemnified and identified, held harmless from any responsibility for loss, damage or injury to any participant, parade viewer, person or property arising from my/our participation in the parade.
5. For the safety of the general public, I/we agree that nothing (candy, trinkets or other items) will be thrown from my/our entry. Note: Participants walking in the parade — as part of the entry — may hand out appropriate items but shall not throw anything or attract parade viewers into the street.
6. The Committee requests that no political advertising or campaign posters be displayed on or by parade entries. While Committee officials recognize that one of the greatest freedoms in our country is the ability to speak freely, we also feel that a politically neutral environment for the parade is what the majority of parade viewers' desire.
7. Prior to and during the parade, I/we agree to follow the instructions of parade officials.
